<p>Overview: The Sports Hall is an indoor open space for use as an indoor activity venue. Activities include five-a-side football, fencing, basketball and as an indoor venue for the Inflatable challenge. All instructed activities have their own risk assessment for indoor sessions e.g. inflatable challenge - otherwise, this is just an open space indoors to be used by groups at their own risk. When use is given over to groups, they are instructed that a responsible adult must be present at all times during the groups use.</p>
